Winter Match Schedule: 22 Rimfire Silhouettes

December 5, 2021 (Sunday) For all matches: Signup at 8:30 am

January 2, 2022 (Sunday) Shoot starts at 9:00 am

February 6, 2022 (Sunday) Match fee: \$5.00

March 6, 2022 (Sunday) (Juniors shoot for free)

April 3, 2022 (Sunday)

If you are looking for a fun and challenging (and relatively cheap) winter shooting activity, come join us at the La Grande Rifle and Pistol Club-100 Yard River Range. All are welcome, club membership is not required, Junior shooters can participate for free and can shoot from any position (younger juniors and first-timers will need to have an adult companion for safety reasons). Eye and ear protection for all participants and spectators is required. Except for Juniors, all firing is done from the standing-offhand

position, no slings, no excuses. .22 Long Rifle rimfire ammunition is typical, no .22 Magnum or .17 caliber ammunition is allowed. Any rifle or pistol and any sights are allowed. Targets are metal silhouettes of chickens, pigs, turkeys, rams, and bears, at distances ranging from 25 yards to 125 yards, and an additional silhouette of a buffalo (or Sasquatch) at approximately 140+ yards. 30 rounds of ammunition (no sighters) is required to complete each relay, we usually shoot at least two relays (three relays if it isn't too "cold"). As long as the wind doesn't blow hard enough to knock the targets over, we will be shooting regardless of the weather conditions.
