MINUTES OF MEETING

July 1, 2020

(Approved as read at August 5 meeting)

The July, 2020 meeting of the La Grande Rifle and Pistol Club (the "Club") was called to order at 7:00 pm by President Karl Baum at the Anderson-Perry Conference Room on N. Fir St. in La Grande. 8 members attended the meeting, including the following members of the 2020 Executive Committee: Karl Baum, Dick Hohstadt, Gary Langlitz, Darrel Plank, Catherine Parks, Trustee Dutch Brogoitti, and Tim Roberts and Martin Creson.

All present stood and recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

The minutes of the June meeting were read and approved and will be posted to the Club website (lgrpc.com).

EXECUTIVE SESSION:

Old Business:

- Danforth Construction is continuing to make final adjustments of the restroom door closers.
- Annual audit has been postponed due to Covid-19 considerations.
- Local law enforcement (Swat Teams) inquired about availability of steel targets for training purposes, Darrel P. to follow up.
- Karl reports that the Grande Ronde Model Watershed is finished with the Spring Creek fish surveys.
- Karl reports that ODOT (Alan Childs) requested permission to park vehicles on range property while ODOT is performing highway maintenance in the area, permission was granted.
- 100 yard clubhouse cleanup was discussed, mud from spring flooding needs to be removed prior to annual SASS match. Karl, Tim, and Darrel to follow up.
- Dutch is working to get a bill for steel pistol targets in progress and is planning to order more targets.
- The Club has 632 members as of the end of June.
- LHS and EOU trap club members may be hired to assist with revamp and cleanup of 25/50 yard targets at 300 yard range, Karl and Darrel to follow up.
- Misuse/damage is still occurring to barrels and target backers at all ranges.
- Darrel is continuing to obtain a cost estimate for the 100 yard range Conex cover.

New Business:

- Darrel and Dutch to develop plan and cost estimates for renovation/replacement of the 100 yard range restrooms.
- Gary reports that an invoice for the OASR membership (due June 16) has not been received. (NOTE: Subsequent to this meeting, Karl contacted OASR and was informed that due to COVID-19, dues notices were not being sent out on time, they will be coming, no action necessary by the Club.)
 - Member liability insurance policy renewal premium is due September 4.
 - Reiterated was the need to seek a volunteer for the Treasurer's position beginning 2021, and also to be looking for members interested in accepting nomination for all officer/trustee positions.

DISCIPLINE REPORTS:

- Darrel P.- Muzzleloader match scheduled for July 11, check the calendar. The annual Rendezvous has been canceled.
 - Darrel P.- .22 Long Range Silhouette had 9 shooters in June, next shoot is scheduled for July 5.
 - No archers report.
 - Dutch reports the June match got rained on, but not out. They are trying out online registration and squadding for the July action pistol match, this system seems to be working.
 - Dick reports 7 shooters for the June .22 Benchrest match, with a top score of 400-36X achieved by Dennis Fuller (possible score is 400-40X). Range conditions were excellent.
 - TAWW-Catherine reports 37 participants for June 6 training session, with excellent help from the Sheriff/OSP safety officers. Next session is June 18, planning to use online registration, also planning for two sessions of 30 participants each. Membership to this TAWW club has been reopened, interest is still strong for this type of training.
 - Tim R. reports 6 shooters at the June Cowboy Action match. The Annual SASS Match will be held in July-check the Calendar.
